

2006 Annual Board Meeting



Called to order by board president Robert Harty. Robert opened by welcoming everyone to the potluck and to the annual meeting. He called all the board members by name so they could be recognized and thanked them for volunteering their time.

Pam gave a financial report. Pam reported that the general operating fund has \$11,294 and the truck account (reserved to make annual truck payments) has a balance of \$16,643. We made a double payment for the second year in a row on our engine. The annual country breakfast this year brought in \$1672 after expenses and we fed a record breaking 599 people!

Robert Harty said a special thanks to Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market (on Crossover) for their donation of eggs and a \$50 gift card toward our purchase of groceries there, Richards Meat Market, Hiland Dairy, Justus Home Center in Elkins, Diaper Depot for a donation of rags, & Southtown Sporting Goods.

Robert then asked Ronnie Wood to say a few things about the department. Ronnie let everyone know that the department has already ran on 92 calls this year. Last year TOTAL we ran on 124. So it has been very busy. He also wanted to make sure everyone knows how much time the firefighters/first responders put in put there and how much they are appreciated.
