New Business:

A truck was donated to us from Arkansas Western Gas. A 2002 Ford 1 ton 4x4 to be used as a brush truck. Lance will paint this truck for us. Cost between \$500 & \$600. A new tank is approximately \$9000 if we supply the pump and \$12,100 for one with a new pump. The complete setup will bolt directly onto the truck once a flat bed has been installed. Flat bed will cost \$1800.00. Payments for the tank and pump would be \$576/month for 2 years.

Jeff Fitch mentioned that there is a stump at Station 2 that the road department can push over if that is OK with the board. After the stump is removed, a bigger whistle can be installed along with gravel and it would make the driveway into that station bigger, making it easier to get the trucks in and out of.
